

## WA HB2237 is Lipstick on a Pig

The abhorrent underbelly of Washington's House of Representatives HB 2237 can be understood only by considering how our three-tiered government functions. We have the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches which are to be separated by their unique decision-making authorities. The Democrat Progressives in the Washington State Legislative Branch and Trial Court Judiciaries seek to create a conglomerate absent responsibility and accountability under the guise of Domestic Violence.
